



Fraser Island Whale Watching 3rd Night Free ex Hervey Bay and Full Day Beauty Spots Tour

Day 1 - Arrive Kingfisher Bay Resort, Fraser Island

Make your way to the Kingfisher Bay Mainland Reception, River Heads (Hervey Bay) to meet the following ferries:

Ferry departs River Heads (Hervey Bay)	0900hrs, 1230hrs, 1530hrs or 1845hrs
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If you are flying into Hervey Bay with Qantas or Virgin Australia we can organise a pick-up (additional cost involved) or if you are on self-drive itinerary we do have. The Kingfisher Bay Ferry departs River Heads for your 50 minute cruise across the Great Sandy Straits to Fraser Island. On arrival you will be meet by the resort representative and transferred to reception to your finalise check-in.

The Kingfisher Bay Jetty Hut is the perfect place to watch the sunset over the Great Sandy Straits with a beer or glass of wine and a bucket of prawns.

Day 2 - Half Day Whale Watching

From 0630 Enjoy a relaxing buffet breakfast at the Maheno Restaurant

0730 Transfers from Reception to the Jetty to meet Quickcat 2

Humpback whales book their holidays in Hervey Bay from early August to end of October. During this time about a thousand humpbacks spend anywhere from a day to two weeks relaxing and nurturing their calves in the sheltered lee of Fraser Island. Because the whales are taking time out from their migration, they provide some of the best whale watching in the world. As they come in close to the boats, they are easily seen in the clear waters of the bay.

Marine rangers/skippers provide commentary and a multimedia presentation.



1200 Arrive back to the resort.
 You have the afternoon at leisure so grab the 'What's on Guide' to see what activities are available or relax with a massage at the Kingfisher Natural Therapy (bookings essential).

Day 3- Full day Beauty Spots Tour

From 0630 Enjoy a relaxing buffet breakfast at the Maheno Restaurant
 0745 Make your way to the Village Square to meet your Ranger for your day's adventure on the world's largest sand island.
 Drive across World Heritage-listed Fraser Island in an air-conditioned 4WD coach to the golden sands of **75-Mile Beach**. Swim in the fresh waters of **Eli Creek** on Fraser Island's eastern beach. See the rusting hulk of the **Maheno Shipwreck** and continue on to the **Coloured Sands** of the **Pinnacles**. Discover the former logging station at **Central Station**. Walk long the boardwalk of **Wanggoolba Creek**. Visit **Pile Valley**, where Fraser famous Satinay trees grow in sand. Take a dip in the clear waters of **Lake McKenzie**, walk around the sandy shoreline or just relax and enjoy the spectacular view.
 1630 Arrive back to the resort.

Day 4- Depart Kingfisher Bay Resort, Fraser Island
